

# Application Development

Efficiently produces error-free code

Costs more per hour than other aspects

Thorough planning reduces time, lowers costs, & increases likelihood the project will succeed

Can include display layer coder (HTML & CSS) as well as programmer (e.g., JavaScript, Rust, Python)

Don't forget database & server admins!

Before you can do QA, you must know how to measure success

QA consists of...

- » Debugging
- » Testing
- » Evaluating

To perform these tasks, you must plan for them

Performed by both experts & stakeholders

1. Discovery
2. Definition
3. Design

6. D-Maintenance

Discover	Inception	Foundation
Design	Elaboration	Blueprinting
Develop	Construction	Building
Deploy	Transition	Evolution

Sometimes it's expressed as a 4-step process, with different names

*Milestones* serve as progress markers or rewards

*Iteration*  occurs at almost all of the 6 steps

Discovery

Gather information to understand purpose, goals, & content: answer *who, what, when, where, & why*

Notice there is no *how*

*Why* do you want the website?

*Who's* the website for, from the perspective of the business *and* the customers?

*What* is the purpose of the website? *What* will it contain?

*When* do you need the website available?

*Where* will the site reside? *Who's* going to manage it?

 PRO TIP

To avoid problems, *always* follow these 2 rules:

1. Write *everything* down
2. *Never* design or code until you have a signed contract & the design is approved

# Definition

Purpose: answer *how* the site will be built

Define scope & structure of your website

Identify potential site features

Set expectations & measures of success

Remember enhancements for the future

Finished when you document the project's scope

No scope changes after this!

## 6. Website Areas of Focus

Areas of focus provide advantages & value to your organization

Should be limited to no more than 7

Last one is always *Mobile-friendly*

5 items for each area of focus

1. *Website goals*: what the website should accomplish
2. *User tasks*: specific things users want to do
3. *Website features*: how the website meets your goals & enables users to accomplish tasks
4. *Success criteria*: how to judge if goals have been met & users can accomplish tasks
5. *Who's in charge*: overseeing roles within your organization

# *Site Map*

Describes the structure of the website, but not what each page looks like


Helps everyone understand the relationships between all the sections & pages

Goal: easy for users to navigate the website

Do not spend a lot of time using fancy software to make a beautiful org-chart style site map\*

Just outline it


\*Unless you work for a design firm that bills clients a lot of money for that stuff

Maintenance is like the 90% of the iceberg below water — people forget or ignore it until it becomes a huge problem


Update content (Who is going to update the content?

Iterate back to start the process over



